

Some Dutch-flagged ships safely pass through Strait of Hormuz

Since the signing of the MoU between the United States and Iran, there have been time windows during which ships have been able to safely leave the Persian Gulf. Some Dutch-flagged ships have also safely made a passage through the Strait of Hormuz. At the same time, a significant portion of the Dutch-flagged fleet will remain in the Persian Gulf for the time being to carry out assignments for offshore activities there.

'After nearly four months, it is positive that Dutch-flagged ships have been able to safely navigate through the Strait of Hormuz. This is primarily a relief for the seafarers, their families, and the shipowners. It is now important that a longer period of calm is established in the area. This way, the ships can operate safely, and transit can resume.' – Annet Koster, director of the Royal Association of Dutch Shipowners.

In view of the developments in the region, no additional details about the shipping company(s), route, or types of ships can be shared at this time. For shipowners, the safety of crew and ship is paramount. They continuously monitor the situation and base their decisions on the most current data.

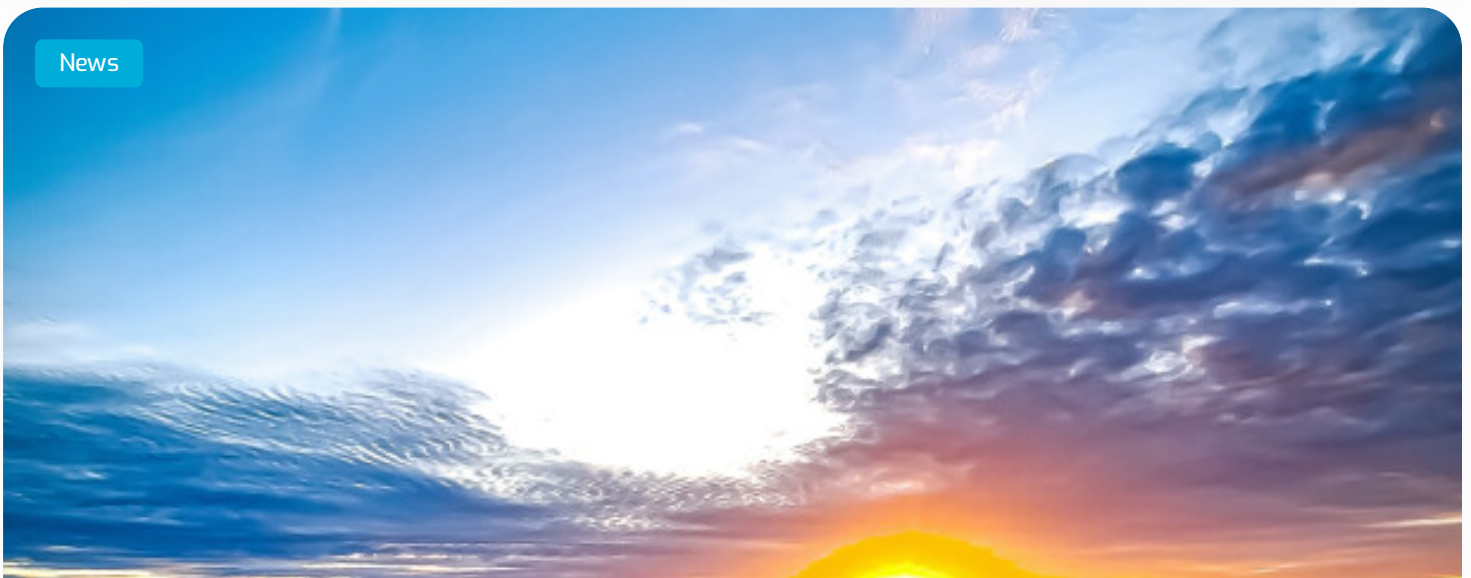


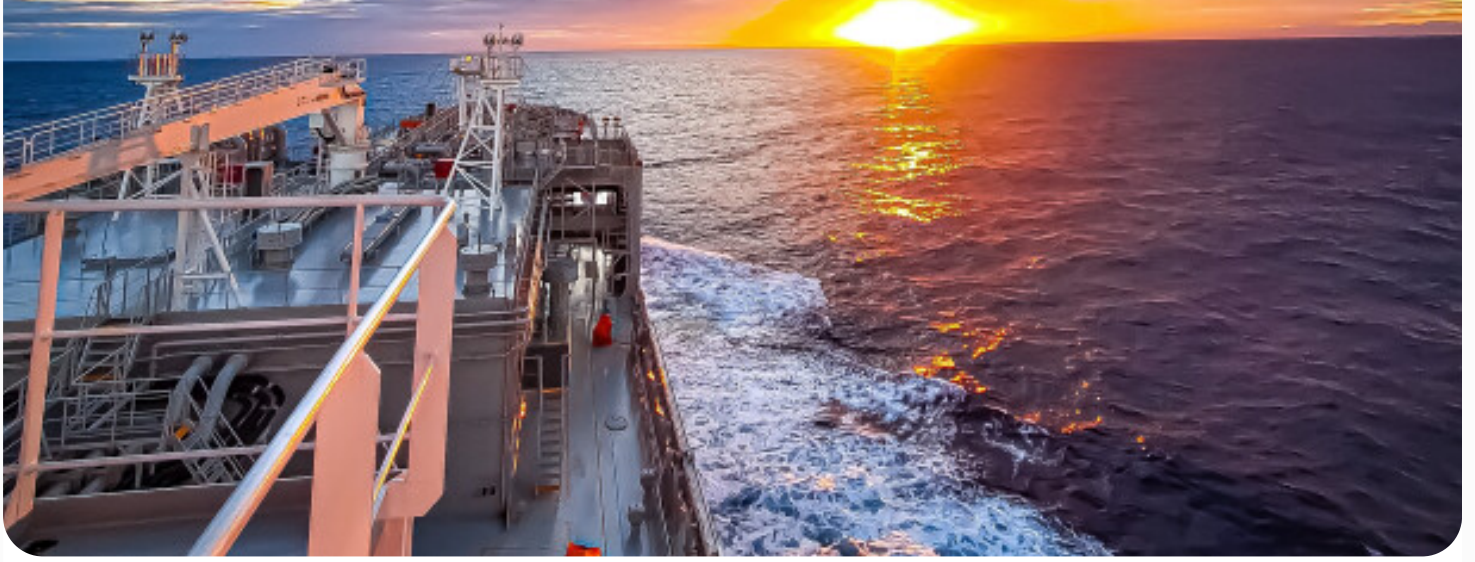
